UZBEKISTAN OPEN PENCAK SILAT CHAMPIONSHIP

Silat enthusiasts and athletes from across the globe had gathered in Tashkent, Uzbekistan, where the city served as the host for the highly anticipated Uzbekistan Open Pencak Silat Championship. This event, which took place from September 27th to October 5th, 2023, offered a captivating display of skill and talent of this traditional martial art.

Various teams from around the world had come together in Tashkent, prepared to showcase their Silat expertise and compete at the highest level. With participants representing diverse cultures and backgrounds, the championship symbolized the spirit of unity through sportsmanship.

The Uzbekistan Open Pencak Silat Championship had not only served as a stage for fierce competition but also as a platform for athletes to build international friendships and mutual respect. As the competitors gathered in the heart of Tashkent, they had the opportunity to learn from one another, share their experiences, and celebrate the beauty of Silat.

Singapore Silat Federation had taken immense pride in being part of this event, dispatching its dedicated athletes to represent the nation and exhibit Singaporean Silat excellence on the international stage. As the championship had unfolded, it had brought forth thrilling matches, stunning displays of talent, and invaluable cultural exchanges that undeniably enriched the global Silat community.







In the peak of this event, we witnessed outstanding achievements from a remarkable group of athletes in both the junior and senior categories. Their dedication and commitment to the art of Silat have brought honor and recognition to their names and their nations.

In the junior category, the gold medal winners were Mohd Ridzqi Bin Mohd Fadhil in Class B, Abdul Raaif Bin Abdul Rashid in Class C for males, Aleesa Hanin Binte Abdul Rahim in Class C, Nur Aniqah Qistina Binte Roslan in Class D, and Maisarah Binte Sahrin in Class E for females. Danial Hariz Bin Rizal secured the silver medal in Class F for males.

In the senior division, gold medalists included Dhani Andika Bin Razali in Class Minus A, Muhammad Shaiman Bin Johanis in Class A, Muhammad Naufal Bin Abdullah in Class C, Ahmad Hanin Bin Abdul Rahim in Class D, Nurhisham Sapari in Class F, Abdul Raaziq Bin Abdul Rashid in Class G, Muhammad Nurshahfareeq Bin Shahrudin in Class H, Sheik Farhan Bin Sheik Alau'ddin in Class J, and Muhamad Rizuan Bin Muhamad Razak in the Open Class for males. For females, the gold medalists were Nur Ellyana Shafiqah Binte Taufik in Class Minus A, Nur Tuhfah Izzah Bte Mohd Roslan in Class A, Nadrah Binte Sahrin in Class B, Rifqah Mursyidah Binte Mistam in Class C, and Nur Shaqirah Binte Sheik Alau'ddin in Class F. Silver medals were earned by Mohd Khairul Fitri Bin Sudirman in Class B and Raja Zulfadhli Bin Raja Mahmud in Class E for males.

The title of the Best Athlete went to Muhammad Shaiman Bin Johanis, and the overall medal count was an impressive 19 gold medals and 3 silver medals.

As we bid farewell to this competition, let's celebrate the accomplishments of all participants and look forward to the promising journeys that lie ahead. We are confident that the legacy of this event will continue to inspire generations of Silat enthusiasts worldwide.

SELIGI TUNGGAL SINGAPURA'S 60TH ANNIVERSARY

On Sunday, October 29th 2023, a special event took place as a Nusantara Silat alliance was launched. This alliance brought together martial arts enthusiasts from Singapore, Malaysia, and Indonesia. It was created in honor of the 60th anniversary of the perguruan, Seligi Tunggal Singapura.

Around 80 Silat schools gathered at the Keat Hong Community Club to celebrate the association's six-decade journey. It was founded in 1963 after getting registered with Persatuan Persuratan Pemuda Pemudi (4PM).

The goal of the alliance is to preserve and promote the Silat tradition. They plan to establish "Seligi Tunggal Nusantara," with Singapore as the central hub for Seligi Tunggal in Malaysia and Indonesia. They have already started training sessions in four regions and will continue this work with existing and future instructors.

This event was organized by Seligi Tunggal Singapura in collaboration with MAEC Keat Hong. It aimed to honor past and present instructors and revive the camaraderie disrupted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Zhulkarnain Abdul Rahim, Grassroots Adviser to Chua Chu Kang GRC GROs (Keat Hong), emphasized the importance of community clubs and understanding the rich heritage of Silat. About 500 guests attended the event, including Silat instructors, cultural enthusiasts, and Malay organizations.

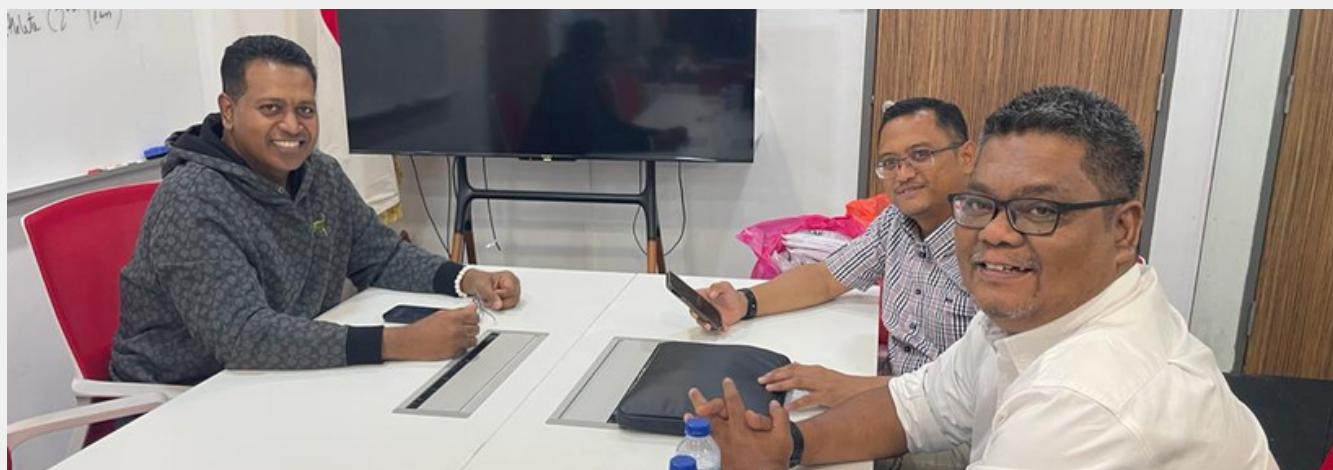

The purpose of the Safe Sport Unified Code and the Safe Sport Programme which supports it are:

- to safeguard participants in the sporting environment from abuse and harassment which undermine both the mental and physical health of participants and the integrity of sport
- to ensure harmonised and coordinated safeguarding framework across the Singapore sporting ecosystem through organisations that are responsible for organising, administering and facilitating participation in sport

Together, the Safe Sport Unified Code and the Safe Sport Programme form the national framework for safeguarding in sport.

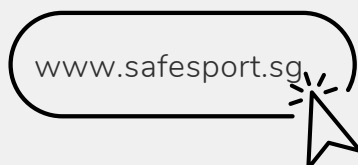
And, as a member of the Safe Sport Programme administered by the Safe Sport Commission, Sport Singapore underlies its commitment to the principle that all participants in sport should expect to play practise, compete, officiate, work, volunteer and interact in an environment that is free from harassment and abuse.

Singapore Silat Federation have appointed its own Safe Sport Officer, who is Mr. Noh Mohd Sharif, in ensuring our Silat enthusiasts practice Silat in a safe environment.

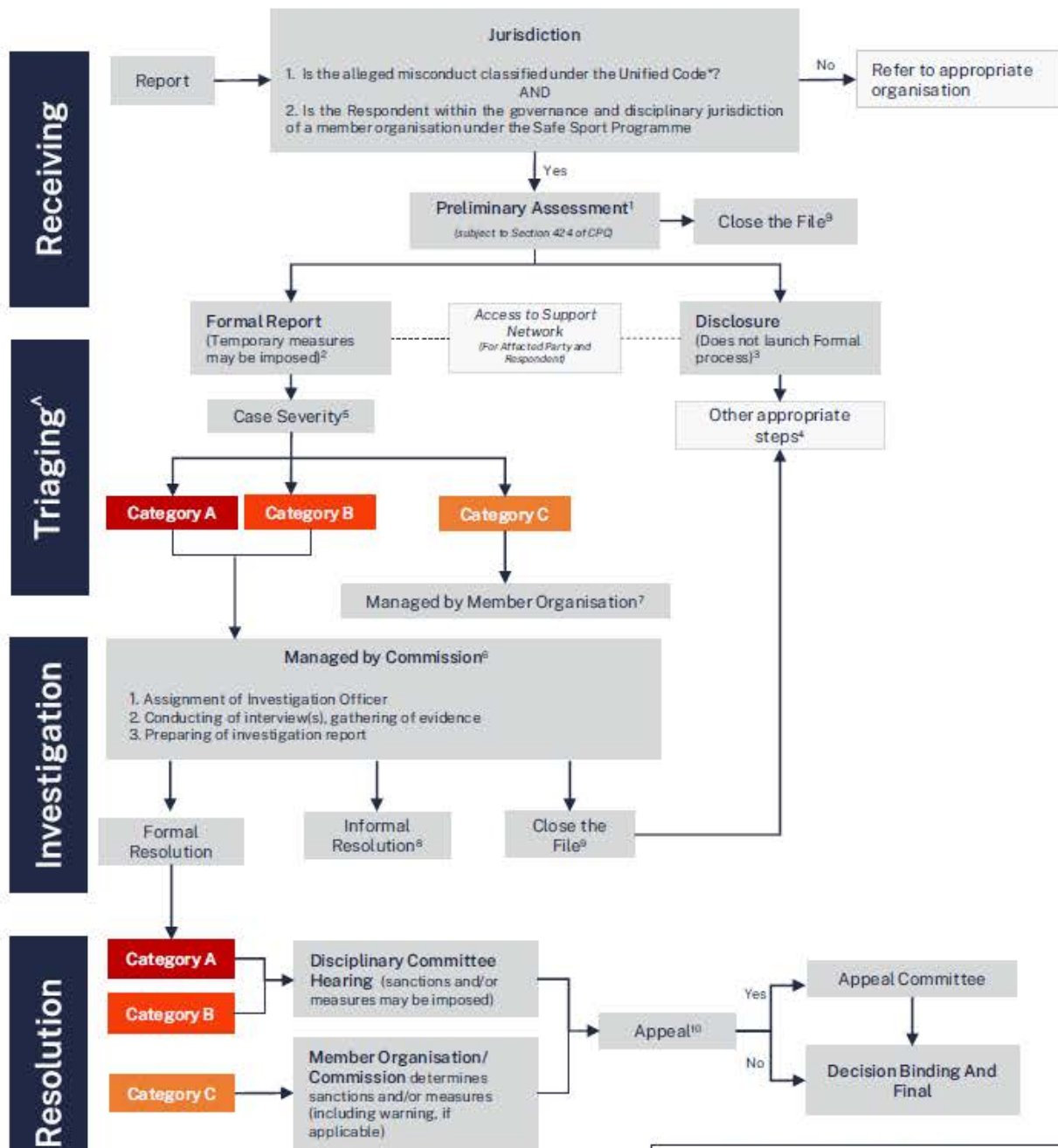
Pursuant to its obligations under Safe Sport Programme, Singapore Silat Federation has:

- adopted the Safe Sport Unified Code and the definitions of Misconduct set out in Article 4 which are sexual, physical and psychological in nature;
- adopted the rules, policies and procedures of the Safe Sport Programme set out in the Safe Sport Programme Handbook for handling allegations of Misconduct;
- delegated jurisdiction and authority to the Safe Sport Commission to
 - i. assess and investigate allegations of Misconduct which are under its discretionary (low level) and mandatory (medium and high level) jurisdiction;
 - ii. issue interim measures pending conclusion of investigations;
 - iii. make recommendations of sanctions or disciplinary action as a result of such investigations;
- delegated jurisdiction and the authority to the committees constituted under the Safe Sport Disciplinary Panel to adjudicate matters referred to it by the Safe Sport Commission.

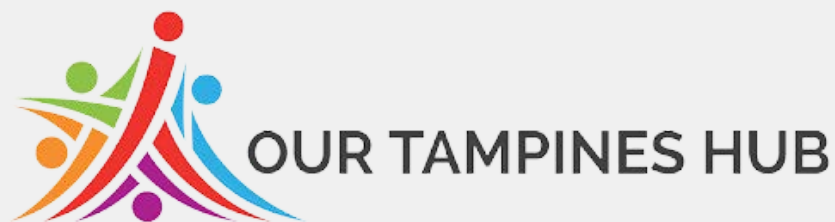

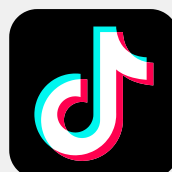
